Sisters and Brothers,

The PSAC has now issued the official Input Call for Bargaining Demands. Our contract expires on June 21, 2011 and we intend to serve notice to bargain on February 21, 2011, which is the earliest possible date pursuant to the Public Service Labour Relations Act.

This NO-Memo will serve as the official input call for the Customs and Immigration Union for all five Treasury Board Bargaining Units (FB, PA, SV, TC & EB). Please send Bargaining Demand proposals to the CIU National Office by July 31, 2011. Please find attached the PSAC Program of Demands, which will be posted on the CIU website under "Program of Demands". This package has been created as a result of bargaining demands that were not successful in previous rounds, issues that surfaced during the life of the current collective agreements, as well as other common PSAC issues. Please note that the Program of Demands is only meant to assist you in your deliberations.

Attached you will also find a copy of the "Proposal for Collective Bargaining" Form, which will also be uploaded to the CIU website at [www.ciu-sdi.ca](http://www.ciu-sdi.ca)

Please complete a form for each and every demand and provide as much information as is available to you. This will facilitate the progress of your bargaining demands when it reaches the National level.

The CIU Collective Bargaining Committee will be meeting in Ottawa August 5 and 6, 2010 to review the demands and setting the priority list of 20 demands for each of the Treasury Board bargaining unit to send to the PSAC by October 1, 2010.
